WHEREAS, the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:12A-1, <u>et seq.</u>, as amended and supplemented (the "Redevelopment Law"), provides a process for municipalities to participate in the redevelopment and improvement of areas in need of rehabilitation or redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 2018:174 adopted on September 11, 2018, the Council of the Borough of Stratford (the "Borough Council") designated Block 53, Lot(s) 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6, as delineated on the Borough of Stratford Tax Map, as a Non-Condemnation Redevelopment Area (the "Redevelopment Area" or "Project Site") in accordance with the Redevelopment Law; and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate the redevelopment of the Redevelopment Area, the Borough Council adopted the "Berlin Road Redevelopment Plan" (the "Redevelopment Plan"), which sets forth, inter alia, the plans for rehabilitation and development of the Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has been in discussion with Stratwin, LLC (the "Conditional Redeveloper"), regarding redevelopment of the Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, Conditional Redeveloper has presented its redevelopment concepts to the Borough, and the Borough and Stratwin, LLC desire that the Redevelopment Area be redeveloped in accordance with the Redevelopment Plan; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-8(f) authorizes the Borough to arrange or contract with a Redeveloper for the undertaking of any project or redevelopment work in an area designated as in need of rehabilitation or redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, the Parties intend to commence to exclusively negotiate toward formulation of a Redevelopment Agreement to develop the Project Site in accordance with the requirements of the Redevelopment Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to designate Conditional Redeveloper as conditional redeveloper in order to negotiate with Conditional Redeveloper for a period of ninety (90) days in an effort to agree upon a Redevelopment Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Borough and Conditional Redeveloper desire to memorialize, in writing, their agreement under a non-binding Memorandum of Understanding that evidences the Parties' statement of intent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Stratwin, LLC is hereby designated as Conditional Redeveloper for the Project Site and the Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding between the Borough and Stratwin, LLC evidencing the Parties' agreement to conduct exclusive negotiations toward the formulation of a Redevelopment Agreement for the Project Site.
