| (4) <i>Matters Relating to Collective Bargaining Agreements</i> : Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body. |
