#### **ORDINANCE 2021:15**

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.16, ENTITLED "FIRE DEPARTMENT," OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF STRATFORD

WHEREAS, the Borough of Stratford is a municipal corporation organized and operating under the laws of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the recommendation has been made to the Governing Body to amend and clarify terminology stated in the Fire Department Code Section, known as the "Fire Ordinance of the Borough of Stratford"; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-2 the Mayor and Borough Council may make, amend, repeal and enforce such other ordinances, regulations, rules and by-laws not contrary to the laws of this state or of the United States, as it may deem necessary and proper for the good government, order and protection of persons and property, and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the Borough and its inhabitants; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Borough Council deem it in the best interest of the Borough to amend Chapter 2.16, entitled "Fire Department".

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Stratford that the Code of the Borough of Stratford is hereby amended, revised and/or supplemented as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 2.16 of the Code of the Borough of Stratford, entitled "Fire Department," is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

#### 2.16.20 Definitions.

Remove in whole the definition for "Fire company".

# 2.16.030 Fire committee – Membership, appointment.

There shall be a fire committee composed of the council director of fire and two (2) other council members, all of which shall be appointed by the Mayor of the Borough of Stratford.

#### 2.16.040 Director of fire.

The director of fire shall be the councilperson appointed by the Mayor of the Borough of Stratford charged with the supervision, responsibility of maintaining and controlling the Stratford Fire Department.

# 2.16.050 Appointment of fire chief and officers of fire department.

The fire chief and all of the other officers of the line of the Stratford Fire Department shall be appointed by the mayor of the borough at the annual reorganization meeting. Members of the Stratford Fire Department shall be appointed by the mayor and council of the borough upon recommendation of the fire chief.

#### 2.16.060 Duties of the fire chief.

In addition to the usual administrative and procedural duties of the chief, he or she shall prepare and submit to the mayor and council, via the director of fire, a monthly report of all fires, calls, services, conditions and actions of the Stratford Fire Department on or before the fifth day of each month for the period of the preceding calendar month.

## 2.16.070 Funding of fire department.

The governing body shall provide in its annual budget such sums as are needed, in its direction, for the maintenance, equipment and supplies necessary to provide for the efficient operation of the fire department.

#### 2.16.090 Insurance.

The mayor and council may maintain and continue any forms of insurance covering the members of Stratford Fire Department which it, the governing body, may determine to be necessary or desirable for the protection, safety and welfare of the members and for the protection and safety of the equipment and apparatus of said fire department, and are authorized by resolution to appropriate, from time to time, such sums of money as may be required to cover the premiums and costs of said insurance, or such portion of the same as the governing body, in its discretion, may consider proper an advisable.

# 2.16.100 Exempt firefighter's certificate.

Any member or officer of the fire department shall be entitled to an exempt firefighter's certificate; provided, however, that he or she qualifies for said certificate by virtue of the eligibility requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:14-56 of the revised statutes of New Jersey and any amendment thereto.

**SECTION 2.** All Ordinances contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent herewith.

**SECTION 3.** If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order of judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon posting, publication, final passage in the manner prescribed by law.

## **RESOLUTION 2021:116**

# RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A MEETING NOT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE NEW JERSEY OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS **ACT, NJSA 10:4-12**

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Stratford is subject to certain requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act, NJSA 10:4-6 et seq., and

WHEREAS, the Open Public Meetings Act, NJSA 10:4-12, provides that an Executive Session, not open to the public, may be held for certain specified purposes when authorized by Resolution, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Governing Body of the Borough of Stratford to discuss in a session not open to the public certain matters relating to the item or items authorized by NJSA 10:4-12b and designated below: (1) Matters required by Law to be Confidential: Any matter which, by express provision of Federal law or State statute or rule of court shall be rendered confidential or excluded from the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act. (2) Matters Where the Release of Information Would Impair the Right to Receive Funds: Any matter in which the release of information would impair a right to receive funds from the Government of the United States. (3) Matters Involving Individual Privacy: Any material the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other personal material of any educational, training, social service, medical, health, custodial, child protection, rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing, relocation, insurance and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or program, including, but not limited to information relative to the individual's personal and family circumstances, and any material pertaining to admission, discharge, treatment, progress or condition of any individual, unless the individual concerned (or, in the case of a minor or incompetent, his guardian) shall request in writing that the same be disclosed publicly. (4) Matters Relating to Collective Bargaining Agreements: Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body. (5) Matters Relating to the Purchase, Lease or Acquisition of Real Property or the Investment of Public Funds: Any matter involving the purchase, lease, or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed. (6) Matters Relating to Public Safety and Property: Any tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public, provided that their disclosure could impair such protection. Any investigations of violations of possible violations of the law. (7) Matters Relating to Litigation, Negotiations and the Attorney-Client Privilege: The topic of discussion is related to Attorney/Client Privilege. These items are for #7 of the Executive Session Resolution for matter relating to litigation, contract negotiations, or the Attorney-Client Privilege. Re: Magnolia Shared Service -Solid Waste, Camden County Vs. Stratford Borough (8) Matters Relating to the Employment Relationship: Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance of promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointed by the public body, unless all the individual employees or appointees whose rights could be adversely affected request in writing that such matter or matters be discussed at a public meeting. Re: Trash Collection

(9) Matters Relating to the Potential Imposition of a Penalty: Any deliberations of a public body

occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty upon the responding party

or the suspension or loss of a license or permit belonging to the responding party bears responsibility.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Stratford, assembled via electronic video conference in public session on August 10, 2021 that an Executive Session closed to the public shall be held on August 10, 2021 at approximately 7:00 p.m. for the discussion of matters relating to the specified items designated above.
